1) Why was the owner worried about her cat when it darted out the door?

The owner had an indoor cat that could get lost or hurt outside.

2) How can a microchip help reunite a lost dog or cat with their owner?

Cats like to roam and can easily get lost in unfamiliar territory and may not be able to find their way home. A microchip is a permanent id tag that can be scanned at a veterinarian's office. An updated microchip will contain the owner's information.

3) At what age can a kitten be microchipped?

Kittens that are at least 8 weeks old can get microchips.
